OVERVIEW

CI-ISAC has been established in Australia to harness the collective insights of all Critical Infrastructure (CI) sectors to provide an information-sharing capability to enable collective cyber defence for its members. We are building a robust, highly-trusted intelligence-sharing community and cyber capabilities for critical infrastructure operators within and across all sectors.

CI-ISAC is a not-for-profit entity that represents an opportunity for industry to self-organise and uplift their own cyber defences in a trusted, sustainable manner. CI-ISAC is purpose driven with a vision that is in harmony with the Commonwealth objective to make Australia the most cyber secure nation by 2030.

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WHY AN ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP?

The strength and utility of an ISAC is directly related to the number of members it has brought together and the diversity of insights and knowledge that these members bring to the ISAC's intelligence sharing platform.

For this reason, we are introducing a new, invite only category of membership called '*Associate Membership*'. The membership will be offered to select Critical Infrastructure organisations (including MSPs and MSSPs that support CI organisations) to join and pilot CI-ISAC for an agreed duration (up to 6 months).

This opportunity will enable CI-ISAC to demonstrate the benefits of closed source, cross-sectoral sharing and the associated intelligence products that these organisations wouldn't have otherwise had access to. The membership operates under the provision that the Associate Member actively engages via sharing and collaboration with CI-ISAC.

SERVICES INCLUDED IN MEMBERSHIP

- ✓ Fortnightly threat sharing sessions with members from across Critical Infrastructure
- ✓ Fortnightly Threat sharing wrap-up/summary based on member sharing from the previous fortnight.
- ✓ Limited access to the member portal and advisories issued from the National Intelligence Office.
- ✓ Sector-based Threat levels based on member observations.



HOW DOES ASSOCIATE DIFFER FROM FULL MEMBERSHIP?

- ✓ **No voting** rights on member resolutions
- ✓ **No access** to the technical Threat Sharing Platform (TSP) or automated threat feed
- ✓ **Reduced** member 'seats' which enable access to CI-ISAC services
- ✓ **Limited access** to the Member Portal
- ✓ **Fixed membership** duration (not annual)
- ✓ **No fees** for the duration of the Associate Membership pilot



ASSOCIATE MEMBER FEATURES

 Cost \$0	Complimentary membership for up to six months by agreement.
 Seats 1-3 depending on organisation size	The number of named employees that are able to participate in CI-ISAC services/engagements and gain access to the member portal.
 Intel Sharing Fortnightly facilitated sessions & ad-hoc sharing via the member portal	Facilitated sessions run by the National Intelligence Office which allow members to share information on cyber threats. All submissions are anonymised prior to being analysed. Members are also able to share at any point via the member portal.
 Threat Levels Cyber Threat Level calculator access	Members from across all critical infrastructure sectors are able to submit cyber threat observations via the member portal, the Cyber Threat Level (national) and by sector is derived from these submissions.
 Member Briefings Fortnightly briefings & on-demand access	Fortnightly briefings by the National Intelligence Office analysts on the latest observed threats.
 Pop-up Sessions Monthly education / threat deep-dive / awareness sessions	CI-ISAC & partner-presented sessions on cyber topics to help build awareness, educate members and inform on relevant threats.
 Intelligence Products Fortnightly Threat Summary - subject to engagement. Advisory summaries (no detail)	Advisories, reports and technical threat information developed by the National Intelligence office to assist members with understanding threats to their environments.
 Member Portal Limited	Dedicated web-based portal for members to access advisories, knowledge and resources available as part of their membership,
 Threat Sharing Platform (TSP) No access	Technical Intelligence Platform with threat profiles on relevant threat actors, campaigns and malware. Also provides access to the CI-ISAC automated threat feed containing relevant technical indicators.
 Member Services Tailored to Associate Member type	CI-ISAC support team to assist members with onboarding, queries and ongoing relationship management.
